Apply NOW for a U.S. Passport

Prepare Now for CAPPA 2019 in Winnipeg

CAPPA 2019 will be held in Winnipeg, Manitoba, Canada, from September 29—October 1. Are you ready for the trip with a valid passport, one that will not expire before the end of the conference?

Canadian law requires that all persons entering Canada carry both proof of citizenship and proof of identity. A valid U.S. passport, passport card, or NEXUS card satisfies these requirements for U.S. citizens. Children under 16 need only present proof of U.S. citizenship.

Anyone with a criminal record (including misdemeanors or alcohol-related driving offenses) may not be able to enter Canada without first obtaining an "approval for rehabilitation" well in advance of any planned travel. You can do a Google search for more information.

Returning to the United States by air, U.S. citizens are required by U.S. law to present a U.S. passport book. Certain alternative documents may be permitted if returning by land (car), but a passport is the gold standard.

U.S. passports cost \$110 (renewal) or \$145 (first-time applicants), and are good for 10 years. Processing time for routine applications, according to the State Department website,

is 4 to 6 weeks.

You will need to submit a photograph with your passport application. You can get passport photos at AAA, Costco, CVS, Sam's, Walmart; or, use one of the free apps for your smartphone.

Your passport is your ticket to the world. If you don't have one yet, or if it is expired or close to it,

this would be an excellent time to get the ball rolling. With your passport you will be ready for CAPPA 2019 in Canada and any future international travels.

The project involves converting high pressure sodium lighting equipment with dark sky compliant LED fixtures.
